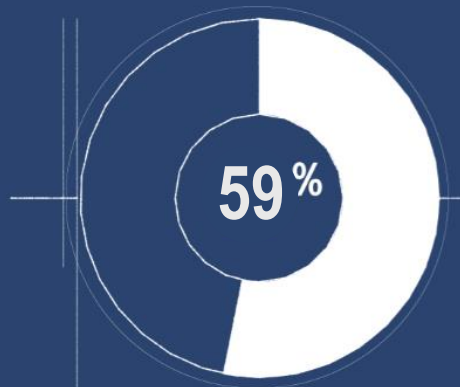

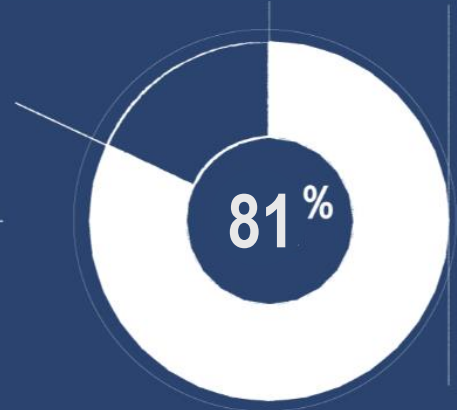
Both leaders and employees are maxed out, but business demands continue to rise. Many see AI agents as the way forward.



of the Houston workforce – employees and leaders – say they lack enough time to do their work



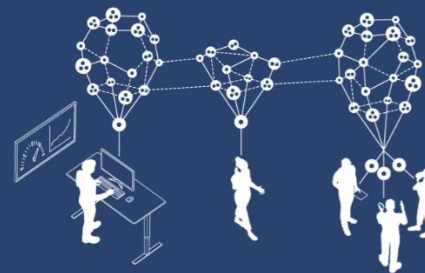
